Call for Research Grants

The University of Coimbra offers three postdoctoral research grants to work on the Project “UID/MAT/00324/2013 - Centro de Matemática da Universidade de Coimbra”, with the following characteristics:

Number of grants: 3

Type of activity: The work will be related to CMUC’s research.

Financial support: FCT/MEC by national funds and by FEDER, Acordo de Parceria PT2020.

Applicant profile: PhD in mathematics or related scientific areas.

Location: Department of Mathematics – Faculty of Sciences and Technology – University of Coimbra

Duration: 12 months.

Renewal: Non renewable.

Scientific Orientation: Professor Maria Manuel Pinto Lopes Ribeiro Clementino.

Financial conditions: The amount of the scholarship is 1.495,00 € paid at the end of each month by bank transfer, plus social security (*seguro social voluntário*, first level contributions) and a personal accidents insurance.

Regime: The attribution of the scholarship does not generate or entitle a relation of a legal-labour nature, it is undertaken in an exclusive dedication regime and the fellow is granted with the Fellow Statute of the University of Coimbra, according to the Regulation of Research Grants of the University of Coimbra and the Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT), both in their latest version.

Selection methods: In a first stage, the jury evaluates the curriculum of the candidates. Candidates who get a mark of at least 75/100 will be interviewed in a second stage. The final grade is a weighted average, with a weight of 4/5 given to the curricular evaluation and 1/5 to the interview. For non-interviewed candidates, the final grade is equal to the mark obtained in the first stage.

Selection and attribution criteria: Curricular evaluation:

Curriculum vitae merit: 60%;

Quality of the work plan quality and adequacy to CMUC’s scientific activity: 30%;

Letters of recommendation: 10%.

Preference will be given to applicants with experience in the areas in which CMUC members are scientifically active.

Formalization of application: Application letter, curriculum vitae, list of publications, work plan and indication of three researchers to whom letters of recommendation can be requested.

Additional information: The evaluation results will be announced within 90 days after the end of the applications submission deadline, by notifying the applicants via email. After the announcement of the results, candidates are considered automatically notified to, if they wish to do so, comment on the results on a preliminary hearing period within 10 days after that date. After this, the selected candidates will have to declare in writing their acceptance. Unless a justification worthy of consideration is presented, if the declaration is not submitted within the referred period, it is considered that the candidate waives the scholarship. In case of resignation or withdrawal of the selected candidate, the next candidate with the highest evaluation score will be notified immediately.
