2. Requirements:

Candidates should have a PhD in Mathematics and at least 3 years of post-doctoral experience with an international-level publication record and demonstrated ability to do independent research. Preference will be given to candidates working in one of the areas in which the members of CMUC are currently active.

The successful applicant is expected to develop research within the areas of interest of CMUC. He/she should also contribute to graduate studies, supervising students from the Department of Mathematics. The research work to be developed will be presented and discussed in periodic meetings at CMUC and will be published in international refereed journals.

can, in case of relevant postdoctoral activity, consider accepting candidates with less than 3 years of post-doctoral activity.

3. Salary: The successful candidates will receive a competitive salary in accordance with the FCT regulations, index 195 on the research career table, Law 124/99, of 20th April, and Law 83-C/2013, of 31st December. The annual gross income, before taxes, will be 2.808,80 or 1.872,53 Euros month, including social and security obligations, depending on the will of the candidate to be integrated in the job proposal under exclusivity or full time regime. Yearly upgrades of the salary will be calculated according to national rules and taxes will be deduced according to the national law. Benefits include social security and 25 days of paid vacation.

4. Type of Contract: Employment contract in public functions, with the duration of 27 months, with a trial period of 30 days.
